Ulaner, MD, PhD, FACNM](#) is Chair of Molecular Imaging and Therapy at Hoag Family Cancer Institute and the James & Pamela Muzzy Endowed Chair of Molecular Imaging and Therapy Professor of Radiology and Translational Genomics, University of Southern California. He is dual board-certified radiologist and nuclear medicine and focuses on FDG PET/CT and novel radiotracer development for patients with breast cancer.

Gary is the principal investigator of four prospective clinical trials of novel PET radiotracers for breast cancer patients, funded by a National Institutes of Health R01 grant, a Department of Defense Breast Cancer Research Programs Award, and a grant from the Susan G. Komen Foundation. These clinical trials emphasize targeted imaging to help direct targeted therapy of cancer, including estrogen receptor- and HER2-targeted therapies.
